The Voting Rights team is organizing to protect the right to vote, given the recent passage of the Amendment 6 ballot initiative which allows the MO legislature to enact strict voter photo ID rules.

As is appropriate and helpful, WE CAN will respond to incidents of racism in West County and the wider St. Louis region by supporting affected persons and demanding accountability from those in power.

WE CAN's weekly Saturday #BlackLivesMatter vigils have continued for over 2 years. Our schedule can be found on our Facebook page and rotates between several West County locations.

ASSIST (A Solid Stay-In-School Team) seeks racial justice for Black and Brown youth in West County school districts and the broader St. Louis region. ASSIST is currently focused on school discipline reform.

WE CAN's Policing team, along with other regional partners, are advocating for municipal police departments to develop policies and practices to address systemic racism.

The Reach Out team connects individuals and organizations working towards similar goals in the wider community through outreach, relationship-building, and community engagement.
